








Conchoecia parvidentata (Müller, G.W., 1906)

Records: 89

This is a species that is very similar to *C. magna* but larger. The majority of records are from the Southern Hemisphere and the records from temperate latitudes are of very dubious validity and may be of large specimens of *C. magna*. There is a lack of good bathymetric data for this species, but it is likely to be a mesopelagic species.
