


Bathyconchoecia lacunosa

Bathyconchoecia lacunosa (Müller, G.W., 1906)

Records: 1

Originally described as a *Euconchoecia* species, this species was attributed to the new genus *Bathyconchoecia* by Deevey (1968b). The majority of *Bathyconchoecia* species are benthopelagic deep slope environments or abyssal depths. Relatively few have been reported either high in the water column or over continental shelves. So the two reports of *B. lacunosa* from shallow shelf seas from along the eastern coast of India (James, 1973) are almost certainly a different species.
